How to get from Warsaw Chopin Airport:

The most convenient and fastest way is **by taxi**: about 7-8 km, 20 minutes. Taxi corporations recommended by *Warsaw Chopin Airport* available just outside the arrival hall:

The estimated cost of the taxi transfer from the airport to the city centre is approx. PLN 40 (approx. EUR 10), but it depends on the time and day of the travel.

Travelling **by bus** takes about 45 minutes. Find the line 188 in front of the Airport and change to line 174 at *GUS* (Główny Urząd Statystyczny – Main Statistical Office) bus stop in direction to *Bokserska* and get off at the third bus stop *Madalinskiego*.

How to get from Warsaw Central Railway Station:

The most convenient – by bus (line 174), about 15 min. Also possible by tram (get off at Pole Mokotowskie tram stop and 600 metres walk), 20 min.

Public Transport

Public transport in Warsaw is well organized, serving the city with buses, trams and Metro (subway).

One-day ticket (cost PLN 15 – ca. EUR 3.6) entitles you to an unlimited number of journeys for 24 hours from its validation.

Single fare transfer ticket costs PLN 4.40 – ca. EUR 1. The type of ticket you should use is called 'normal' ('full-price ticket'), and may be purchased at newsagent's or in public transport vending machines, available at many bus stops, tram stops and metro stations.

You may also download a smartphone application **jakdojade.pl** – it will help you to move around the city without getting lost. It is available in English, but in order to use it you will need to have an access to the Internet on your smartphone.
